

# *Fall 1983 Baldwin Trophy Winner Peter Barney's On2 Beyer Garrett*



The model was built in On2 to resemble a South African Railways two foot gauge Beyer Garratt. The engine frame is an HO Athearn 40 foot flat car, the boiler is a paper wrapped large wooden dowel. The main frames, drivers, valve gear, etc. are from a Tyco HO Mallet locomotive. The motor is in the rear unit and uses vertical gears to reach the driver gearing, The front unit is unpowered and just rolls along. The superstructures are styrene and many parts are brass from Kemtron/Precision Scale.
