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NER Corporate Agent

CORPORATE STATUS:

The NER is a non-profit New Jersey corporation, established in 1953. The corporation is represented by an Agent appointed by the BOD. The Agent must be a resident of New Jersey, but does not have to be a member of the NER.

DUTIES:

The duty of the Agent is to file Annual Report forms which list officers, agent and home office. Each filing or change requires a fee, which must be paid with separate checks for each transaction. Corporate or personal checks are acceptable. The corporate agent shall submit a receipt to the treasurer for reimbursement.

The Annual Report can be signed by the President or the Corporate Agent.

A change in the Corporate Agent name or address requires BOD approval, and must be signed by the President. Any change is usually processed concurrently with the Annual Report filing.

PROCEDURE:

The Annual Report shall be filed using the form prescribed by the State of New Jersey. Filing is due in November, but can occur up to one year later without penalty. The filing is currently made after the Fall Annual Meeting and installation of officers to ensure that the report is current. The State does not appear to verify any information.

If two consecutive filings are missed, the Corporate status is revoked. The State does not notify the corporation of the revocation, and does not send any additional annual report forms.

In the event of revocation, reinstatement is possible with the filing of an application form signed by the President and payment of all past filing fees and a penalty fee.
