



**Northeastern Region NMRA
Annual Meeting of the Members
Monday, October 11, 2021
Westford Regency Inn & Conference Center, Westford, MA**

1. President Ed O'Rourke called the meeting to order at 10:02 am

The attendance sheet is included in these minutes as Attachment (1). A total of 42 NMRA members were in attendance. A quorum being present, the meeting could proceed.

2. President O'Rourke called for the standard reports.

- **Secretary's Report**

There was not an annual meeting conducted in 2020, and therefore no minutes could be reviewed.

- **Treasurer's Report**

Treasurer Gerry Covino submitted a report included with these minutes as Attachment (2). Treasurer Covino reported the Region is "financially in good shape." He said the Edward Jones account is funded at more than \$66,000. He said the biggest expense is the Coupler magazine; second biggest expense is the Achievement Program (AP); and third is the communications budget.

He reported that the Region has received the first refund from National for cancelled conventions. He asked that Divisions and those expecting a refund should contact him ASAP so the money can be distributed.

Treasurer Covino said he can now be reached at <treasurer@nernmra.org>.

President O'Rourke noted that Treasurer Covino would incur a conflict of interest in his position as Eastern Director on the NER BOD as the Board oversees the treasurer. Therefore, Treasurer Covino stepped down as Eastern Director. President O'Rourke announced that Erich Whitney is assuming that position.

- **Convention Committee Report**

Convention Committee Chair David Insley reported NERx will be an ongoing program with the next one scheduled for March 13-24, 2022. Chair Insley said he is seeking content for NERx, including layout presentations (25 mins.) and clinics (45 mins.).

Chair Insley reported the contract is signed for the next NER convention sponsored by the Nutmeg Division in Windsor, CT, in 2022. He said Sunrise Trail Division is actively looking for sites for the 2023 convention. He said the 2024 convention location is still open; 2025 is scheduled for the Lakeshores Division, which he said is actively engaged in setting it up. He also reported that the NER and Eastern Canada Division will partner with

the Maritime Federation of Model Railroaders (MFMR) to participate in a spring 2023 convention during Memorial Day weekend.

- **Achievement Program Report**

The AP awards announced by AP Chair Bill Brown at the convention are included with these minutes as Attachment (3). Also in Attachment (3) are the Region awards.

- **Coupler Editor's Report**

President O'Rourke commented that Editor Chris Carfaro "can only print what he gets from people," who don't have to be 'Hemingway' because "Chris can edit it."

- **Webmaster's report**

President O'Rourke said Webmaster David Abrames has been ill and is trying to catch up. President O'Rourke said there is a need for an "associate webmaster."

Model Contest Chair Ken May said he would like to get information on past contest winners and subjects modeled on the Website.

- **NER Staff Reports**

Outgoing Nominating Committee Chair Kevin Katta reported that Metro North, Garden State, and Sunrise Trail divisions are having a joint meet October 30 at the Northlandz attraction in Flemington, New Jersey.

- **Model Contest Chair Report**

Attachment (4) provides the Mill City21 Model Contest Report. This report from NER Convention Model Contest Chair Ken May was not presented at the meeting but reflects the awards presented at the banquet and is included here for the record.

- **Photo Contest Chair Report**

Attachment (5) provides the Mill City21 Photo Contest Report. This report from NER Convention Photo Contest Chair Kaylee Zheng was not presented at the meeting but reflects the awards presented at the banquet and is included here for the record. Chair Zheng announced that she was stepping down as Photo Contest Chair due to increased workload in her professional jobs. She announced that Mike Tylick would be taking over as chair.

3. **President's Report**

President O'Rourke commented on his participation in the NMRA. He said he had been a member years earlier, and later signed up again at a model train show thanks to Jim Heidt of the CNY Division. President O'Rourke cited Andy McVie of Western New York (NFR) for coining the phrase "I am the NMRA."

President O'Rourke appointed outgoing NER President Bob Dennis as "Special Assistant to the President" concentrating on membership.

President O'Rourke noted that it is not good that so few divisions are taking advantage of the NMRA Division Member Retention Fund. He said he can forward the Website information to those interested in these matching funds for keeping members through Websites, etc. He said the Membership Committee will be looking into encouraging programs for member retention. President O'Rourke cited Chuck Diljak for the great job he is doing in membership communication through Constant Contact. The president further stated that Division activities need to be publicized in the NER Coupler and that Divisions need to send material for publication. He also cited Jeff Hanke's column in the Coupler. Editor Chris Carfaro said the NER Coupler is open to adding columns and accepting articles for publication.

President O'Rourke thanked Division directors for keeping NER programs active through the pandemic, and for "keeping the NMRA message out there."

He went on to say the reason he recently received his MMR designation was because of volunteers like Bill Brown and Dave Martini in the CNY Division who showed up to judge his work on a bitter cold day. President O'Rourke observed, "They *are* the NMRA!"

4. President O'Rourke opened the floor to any other comments or questions.

Newly elected Western Director Ed Olszewski asked about differences in print and online editions of the NER Coupler. Editor Carfaro said the main difference amounted to corrections or clarifications in material from the print edition.
