**SPACE USAGE ON THE PAGES OF THE NER COUPLER**

Each issue of the NER Coupler has sixteen pages. Of the sixteen, approximately seven are earmarked for: regular columns, the front cover, and the back cover. This leaves approximately nine pages for flexible content. Typically the annual convention will hold one to four of those pages. The space thereafter is then given to submitted articles, photos and announcements.

Page 3 *Editor column, Asst. Editor column*

Pages 6-10 *2023 Convention: Cannonball Express promotion*

Page 11 *New/Events/new members +, NMRA ad, Photo contest, submitted photo*

Pages 12 *"Workin' on the Railroad"*

Page 13 *1/2 pg workin' on Railroad cont. + Memorial*

Page 14 *Tylick Tool Co.*

Page 15 *Submitted article: Model Railroader..., + Memorial*

Page 16 *back cover: USPS space for mailing, NER directory*

Submitted articles can vary quite a bit. Sometimes taking only a 1/4 page, other times as much as two or more pages. Larger submissions may be spread over several issues or the author may reduce the overall size.

Occasionally a business buys a "sponsorship" which adds four pages. The sponsor gets two full pages and the NER Coupler gains two pages for content.
